



CRNI has been awarded funding to undertake a project to design a viable business model that will encourage State agencies (and eventually other organisations) to donate unwanted bulky items for reuse or community recycling, where reuse is not possible. This may be likened to the service provided by FoodCloud, which helps to channel unwanted foodstuff into the reuse loop, providing a short turnaround time and other value offers that make it worthwhile for donors to engage.

PROJECT MANAGER (PART-TIME) - ROLE SPECIFICATION

The Project will require the successful candidate to demonstrate experience and proven results in several relevant areas. The successful applicant must be able to work on their own initiative, collaborate with different groups, ensure deadlines are met and devise, manage and implement the project scope, plan and timelines.

The project timeframe is estimated to be approximately 10 months and it is envisaged that the project manager will need to commit to working 3 days per week for the duration of the project. The project will involve several trips throughout Ireland.

ESSENTIAL REQUIREMENTS

At least 3-5 years' experience in the following areas:

- Project management
- Experience in business model development
- Extensive stakeholder engagement
- In-depth research using a multitude of sources
- Market research and communications
- Conducting surveys of various stakeholder groups and/or consumers
- Report writing
- Managing project finances

The successful candidate will also need to have:

- A degree or equivalent qualification in a related discipline such as Business / Environmental studies
- Comprehensive IT skills
- Excellent interpersonal skills
- An ability to engage with a range of stakeholders
- A high standard of written English

- Experience in the reuse/recycling sector
- Experience with a project of similar scope

SALARY

The salary payable will depend on the experience of the successful candidate and will be in the range of €38,000-€42,500 per annum (pro-rata).
